PUBLIC NOTICE OF HEARING ON APPLICATION FOR A CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY P.D.M. ENERGY L.L.C.

P.D.M. Energy L.L.C. ("Company") has filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an Application for authority to operate as a retail electric service provider in the State of Arizona. If the Application is granted, the Company will be permitted to provide competitive electric services at retail.

The Application is available for inspection during regular business hours at the offices of the Commission in Phoenix, at 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona and at the Company's offices, P.D.M. Energy L.L.C., 2600 North Central Avenue, Phoenix, Arizona 85004.

The Commission will hold a hearing on this matter on March 12, 2001, at 10:00 a.m. or as soon thereafter as is practical, at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona, 85007.

As a property owner or customer you may have the right to intervene in the proceeding. If you do not want to intervene, you may appear at the hearing and make a statement on your own behalf. Intervention shall be permitted to any person entitled by law to intervene and having a direct and substantial interest in the matter. Persons desiring to intervene must file a written notice to intervene with the Commission, which motion should be sent to the Company or its counsel and to all parties of record and which, at the minimum, shall contain the following:

1. The name, address and telephone number of the proposed intervenor and of any party upon whom service of documents is to be made if different than the intervenor.

2. A short statement of the proposed intervenor's interest in the proceeding (e.g., a customer of the Company, a shareholder of the Company, etc.).

3. A statement certifying that a copy of the motion to intervene has been mailed to the Company or its counsel and to all parties of record in the case.

The granting of motions to intervene shall be governed by A.A.C. R14-3-105, except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before March 2, 2001 by 12:00 noon. The granting of intervention, among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at hearing and to cross-examine other witnesses. Failure to intervene will not preclude any person from appearing at the hearing and making a statement on such person's own behalf. Public comment will be taken prior to the commencement of the hearing on March 12, 2001 at 10:00 a.m. However, you will not receive any further notice of the proceeding unless requested by you.

The Commission does not discriminate on the basis of disability in admission to its public meetings. Persons with a disability may request a reasonable accommodation such as a sign language interpreter, as well as request this document in an alternative format, by contacting Shelly Hood, ADA Coordinator, voice phone number 602-542-3931, E-mail: shhood@cc.state.az.us. 



