- D. Please identify possible programming languages that your Company may utilize.
- E. Please provide a thorough an answer to B-2(a). Describe the customer class to be served, the expected number of customers in each class and the average number of kWhs which the applicant will market each month.
- F. Please provide a thorough answer to B-2(b). Identify your Company's key technical and operational personnel including their names, titles and length of

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experience in the sale, procurement, metering, and billing of energy services or similar products.


G. Provide your billing and collection charge in your tariff.

If this information is not received within 60 days of the date of this letter, Staff may terminate this application. This information must be received by Docket Control within 30 days of the date of this letter. Please mail an original plus 10 copies to: Docket Control, Arizona Corporation Commission, 1200 W. Washington Street, Phoenix, AZ 85007-2927. If no response is received within 60 days of the date of this letter, Staff will recommend that the application be terminated. If the application is terminated, the Applicant cannot provide competitive retail electric service until such time as a new application is filed with and approved by the Commission.

However, please note that Pursuant to A.A.C. R14-2-1603(E), each applicant is required to notify Affected Utilities, Utility Distribution Companies and electric utilities not subject to the jurisdiction of the Arizona Corporation Commission in whose service territories it wishes to offer service of the application by providing the above with copy of the application. Each applicant is required to provide written notice to the Commission that it has provided such notification. PDM Energy, LLC, has yet to provide written notice to the Commission. Continued failure to comply with this rule may result in your application being terminated.
