FINDINGS OF FACT


- 15 1. David D. Stevenson d/b/a Stevenson Investments ("Applicant") has a Certificate of
16 Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate") to provide customer-owned pay telephone ("COPT")
17 service in the State of Arizona pursuant to Decision No. 59156 (July 20, 1995).
- 18 2. On August 13, 1996, Applicant filed with Docket Control of the Commission an
19 application for approval of the cancellation of the Certificate, indicating that it no longer provides
20 COPT service in the State of Arizona.
- 21 3. In Decision No. 55817 (December 10, 1987), the Commission found that COPT
22 providers were public service corporations subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission.
- 23 4. Decision No. 57797 (April 8, 1992) adopted A.A.C. R14-2-901 through R14-2-909 to
24 regulate COPT providers.
- 25 5. Decision No. 58535 (February 14, 1994) adopted a Generic Tariff that establishes
26 rates and minimum service standards applicable to COPT service.

ORDER


