

In the matter of the Application of American Fiber Systems, Inc. for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to Provide Competitive Intrastate Telecommunication Service:

- This application is sufficient.
- The application is insufficient and lacks the following items:

1. Pursuant to A.A.C. R14-2-503(B), the amount of a deposit required by the utility shall not exceed 2 times that residential customer's estimated average monthly bill or the average monthly bill for the customer class for that customer which ever is greater. Nonresidential customer deposits shall not exceed 2 ½ times that customer's estimated maximum monthly bill. The term "deposit" refers to all deposits, advance payments, and prepayments. The combined amount charged for deposits, advance payments, and prepayments, must be in compliance with the amount allowed by this rule.
2. List the states in which you currently offer any telecommunications services, and indicate the services you offer in each state.

If this information is not received within **71 days** of the date of this letter, Staff may terminate this application. Please mail an original plus 10 copies to: Docket Control, Arizona Corporation Commission, 1200 W. Washington Street, Phoenix, AZ 85007-2927.

Applicant is required to publish legal notice of the application in all counties where services will be provided.


