PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

By Procedural Order dated September 12, 2005, the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") established deadlines for filing briefs in the above-captioned matter. Opening Briefs were due October 3, 2005 and Responsive Briefs were due October 24, 2005.

On September 29, 2005, Level 3 Communications ("Level 3") and Qwest Corporation ("Qwest") filed a Joint Motion for Modification of Procedural Order. The parties indicate that they have been engaged in productive settlement discussions and believe that extending the deadline would enable them to reach a negotiated resolution of the disputed issues. They requested that the procedural schedule be modified to have Opening Briefs due November 30, 2005 and Responsive Briefs due December 21, 2005.

Under the circumstances, the request is reasonable and should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the September 12, 2005 Procedural Order is modified as set forth herein and that the parties shall file simultaneous **Opening Briefs** on or before **November 30, 2005**. In their Opening Briefs the parties shall identify any material issues of disputed facts that would prevent a complete resolution of this matter without a hearing.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties shall file simultaneous **Responsive Briefs** on or before **December 21, 2005**.

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all other provisions of the September 12, 2005 Procedural
2 Order shall remain in effect.

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113-Unauthorized
4 Communications) continues to apply to this proceeding.

5 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend, or waive
6 any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.


