**ORDER**

Open Meeting

**BY THE COMMISSION:**

Having considered the entire record herein and being fully advised in the premises, the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") finds, concludes, and orders that:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. On January 13, 2000, Suzanne E. Tumlinson dba J & J Vending ("Applicant") submitted to Docket Control of the Commission an application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate") to provide customer-owned pay telephone ("COPT") service in the State of Arizona. The application was docketed on January 13, 2000.

2. In Decision No. 55817 (December 10, 1987), the Commission found that COPT providers were public service corporations subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission.

3. The Commission in Decision No. 57797 (April 8, 1992) adopted A.A.C. R14-2-901 through R14-2-909 to regulate COPT providers.

4. In Decision No. 58535 (February 14, 1994), the Commission adopted a Generic Tariff that establishes rates and minimum service standards applicable to COPT service.

5. Pursuant to A.R.S. § 40-282, the Commission may issue Decisions regarding COPT Certificates without a hearing.

6. Applicant has requested that a Certificate be granted pursuant to A.A.C. R14-2-905, and has indicated that it will provide COPT service pursuant to the rates, terms and conditions

1 specified in the Generic COPT Tariff.

2 7. Applicant is an Arizona corporation.

3 8. Applicant does not presently provide COPT services in Arizona.

4 9. Applicant submitted a sample customer information posting for the review of the  
5 Commission's Utilities Division Staff ("Staff").

6 10. On February 10, 2000, Staff filed a Staff Recommendation, recommending approval  
7 of Applicant's application without a hearing.

8 11. Staff stated that the sample customer information posting is not in compliance with the  
9 Generic COPT Tariff.

10 12. Staff recommended that Applicant be ordered to file a revised copy of its customer  
11 information posting with Staff for approval prior to it providing service at any location.

12 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

13 1. Applicant is a public service corporation within the meaning of Article XV of the  
14 Arizona Constitution and A.R.S. §§ 40-281 and 40-282.

15 2. The Commission has jurisdiction over Applicant and the subject matter of the  
16 application.

17 3. Notice of the application was given in accordance with the law.

18 4. The provision of COPT service in Arizona by Applicant is in the public interest.

19 5. Applicant is a fit and proper entity to receive a Certificate for providing COPT service  
20 in Arizona.

21 **ORDER**

22 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the application of Suzanne E. Tumlinson dba J & J  
23 Vending for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity for authority to provide customer-owned pay  
24 telephone service in Arizona shall be, and the same is, hereby granted.

25 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Suzanne E. Tumlinson dba J & J Vending shall file a  
26 revised customer information posting within 30 days of the date of this Order for approval by the  
27 Director of the Utilities Division.

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
