BY THE COMMISSION:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. WorldCom Technologies, Inc. (WorldCom) is certificated to provide intrastate telecommunications service as a public service corporation in the State of Arizona.

2. On December 10, 1998, WorldCom filed tariff revisions to restructure the monthly recurring and non-recurring charges and the discount schedule of the Metro Frame Relay Service:

Intrastate Telecommunications Services

- Arizona Tariff No. 2, Section 9 - Page 1, 2nd Revised
- Arizona Tariff No. 2, Section 9 - Page 7, 1st Revised
- Arizona Tariff No. 2, Section 9 - Page 8, 1st Revised

3. WorldCom is increasing the recurring and non-recurring charges, while decreasing the ancillary charges for Metro Frame Relay Service.

4. Since this filing increases the maximum rates for a component of a service that has been classified as competitive under the Commission's Competitive Telecommunications Services Rules, A.A.C. Rule R14-2-1110 regarding rate increases, applies to WorldCom's proposal.

5. WorldCom provided information indicating the expected revenue effect of approval of the filing. The cumulative effect of these rate changes is an expected net revenue increase of \$320 per month.

6. Staff has recommended approval of the filing.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. WorldCom is certificated to provide intrastate telecommunications service as a public service corporation in the State of Arizona.

2. The Commission has jurisdiction over WorldCom and over the subject matter of the application.

3. The Commission, having reviewed the tariff pages (copies of which are contained in the Commission's tariff files) and Staff's Memorandum dated September 7, 1999, concludes that the proposed tariff revisions are reasonable, fair and equitable, and are therefore in the public interest.

ORDER


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the filing be and hereby is approved.
