13 FINDINGS OF FACT

14 1. U S WEST Communications, Inc. (U S WEST) is certificated to provide telephone
15 service as a public service corporation in the State of Arizona.

16 2. On March 3, 1999, U S WEST filed tariff revisions to add a new feature: Caller ID with
17 Privacy +.

18 3. This service adds the ability to screen private or unidentified calls to the basic Caller
19 ID Name and Number service. With this service, incoming private or unidentified calls screened and
20 the caller must identify themselves in either of two ways. The first method would be to unblock
21 their line for that call only. The second would be to verbally record their name for use in announcing
22 the caller to the called party.

23 4 USWC is proposing a maximum monthly rate of \$21.90 for business customers and
24 \$19.90 for residence customers. The initial monthly rates for business and residence customers will
25 be \$10.95 and \$9.95, respectively. USWC is also proposing a maximum rate of \$5.90 and an initial
26 rate of \$2.95 for residence customers who subscribe to its CustomChoice package.

1 5. On March 25, 1999, U S WEST revised the filing to eliminate its proposed pricing

11 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

12 1. U S WEST is an Arizona public service corporation within the meaning of Article XV,
13 Section 2, of the Arizona Constitution.

14 2. The Commission has jurisdiction over U S WEST and over the subject matter of the
15 application.

16 3. Approval of the filing will not result in an increase in rates as contemplated by A.R.S.
17 Section 40-250.

18 4. The Commission, having reviewed the tariff pages (copies of which are contained in the
19 Commission's tariff files) and Staff's Memorandum, concludes that the tariff filing, as amended, is
20 reasonable, fair and equitable, and is therefore in the public interest.
