On behalf of Telseon Carrier Services, Inc. ("Telseon"), and in accordance with the Arizona Corporation Commission's Order of August 30, 2001, please be advised that Telseon will begin offering services in Arizona on November 17, 2001. The services that Telseon will offer at that time will not include dial-tone services to end-user customers. Its initial service offerings will consist of broadband and high-speed digital private line services to business customers using a public IP-based network that employs proprietary gigabit ethernet technology. Telseon's network will enable point-to-point, point-to-multipoint, and multipoint-to-multipoint network connections and will be designed to enable high-speed access to application service providers ("ASPs"), Internet service providers ("ISPs"), and other types of service providers. Telseon's initial offerings will also include point-to-point connections at 2.5 gigabits per second and 10 gigabits per second via advanced Dense Wavelength Division Multiplexing equipment, a technology which will support Gigabit Ethernet, SONET, Fiber Channel, and other protocols.
