NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY TO PROVIDE COMPETITIVE RESOLD INTEREXCHANGE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES BY STERLING TIME COMPANY

STERLING TIME COMPANY ("Applicant") has filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate") to provide competitive resold interexchange telecommunications services in the State of Arizona. Applicant will be required by the Commission to provide this service under the rates and charges and terms and conditions established by the Commission. A.R.S. 40-282 provides that the Commission may act on an application for a Certificate to provide resold telecommunications services without a hearing, or with a hearing, if one is requested by any party. Under appropriate circumstances interested parties may intervene in the proceedings and participate as a party. Intervention shall be in accordance with A.A.C. R14-3-105, except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before July 5, 2001. You may have the right to intervene in the proceeding, or you may make a statement for the record, if you have any comments, mail them to:
