PROCEDURAL ORDER

**BY THE COMMISSION:**

On March 14, 2000, OnePoint Services, L.L.C. ("OnePoint" or "Company") filed with Docket Control of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate") to provide competitive resold local exchange telecommunications services within the State of Arizona.

On August 8, 2000, the Company filed Affidavits of Publication indicating compliance with the Commission's notice requirements.

On September 27, 2000, the Commission's Utilities Division Staff ("Staff") filed its Staff Report in this matter.

On December 11, 2000, a Procedural Order was issued requiring the Company to file fair value rate base information within 30 days of the date of that Procedural Order.

On February 10, 2001, the Company filed its fair value rate base information.

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 40-282, the Commission may act on an application for a Certificate to provide resold telecommunications services without a hearing, or with a hearing if one is requested by any party.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the deadline for processing this application shall be extended to August 8, 2001.

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
