Dear Mr. Sessions:

If at the time Mr. Mosier made the Application complete on January 5, 2000, that in fact he may have unintentionally did it at that time. The point is that it is not complete and from my previous letter we do need the following as stated items. I cannot complete this Application without these requested items.

On October 19, 1999, CNG Communications, Inc. filed an application for a CC&N to provide resold intrastate toll telecommunications in the State of Arizona. Pursuant to A.A.C. R14-2-1104(E), the Applicant is required to publish legal notice of the application in all counties where services will be provided no later than 20 days after the application is filed. The Applicant must file with the Commission copies of the affidavits of publication for each newspaper in which public notice in this matter was published.

Additionally, upon review of the application, staff has determined that the Applicant will need to submit the following information: a list of states in which CNG is providing similar services; a detailed description of CNG's technical ability to provide the proposed services; and a more detailed description of the services CNG proposes to provide in the State of Arizona.

Your response to this request must be received by Docket Control within 30 days of the date of this letter. If no response is received within 60 days of the date of this letter, Staff will recommend that the application be terminated. If the application is terminated, the Applicant cannot provide resold intrastate toll telecommunications in Arizona, until such time as a new application is filed with and approved by the Commission.
