On July 7, 2005, Perkins Mountain Utility Company ("Perkins Utility") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate") to provide wastewater, and Perkins Mountain Water Company ("Perkins Water") to provide water, to two master-planned communities in Mohave County, Arizona. Golden Valley South consists of 5,750 acres and is located approximately five miles southeast of Kingman, Arizona. The Villages at White Hills consists of approximately 2,727 acres and is located along U.S. Highway 93, approximately 29 miles south of Hoover Dam. If the Application is granted, Perkins Utility and Perkins Water would be the exclusive provider of wastewater and water service to the proposed areas, and would be required by the Commission to provide service under rates and charges and terms and conditions established by the Commission.

The application is available for inspection during regular business hours at the offices of the Commission in Phoenix, at 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona or in Tucson at 400 West Congress Street, Suite 218, and at the Companies' offices, 2215 Hualapai Mountain Road, Suite H, Kingman AZ 86401.

The Commission will hold a **hearing** on this matter on **December 5, 2005 at 10:00 a.m.**, or as soon thereafter as is practical, at the Commission's offices, 1200 W. Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona. Public comment will be taken on the first day of the hearing.

The law provides for an open public hearing at which, under appropriate circumstances, interested parties may intervene. Intervention shall be permitted to any person entitled by law to intervene and having a direct and substantial interest in the matter. Persons desiring to intervene must file a written notice to intervene with the Commission, which motion should be sent to the Applicants or their counsel and to all parties of record, and which, at the minimum, shall contain the following:

1. The name, address, and telephone number of the proposed intervenor and of any party upon whom service of documents is to be made if different than the intervenor.
2. A short statement of the proposed intervenor's interest in the proceeding (e.g., a customer of the Applicants, a shareholder of the Applicants, etc.).
3. A statement certifying that a copy of the motion to intervene has been mailed to the Company or its counsel and to all parties of record in the case.

The granting of motions to intervene shall be governed by A.A.C. R14-3-105, except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before November 4, 2005. The granting of intervention, among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at hearing and to cross-examine other witnesses. Failure to intervene will not preclude any customer from appearing at the hearing and making a statement on the customer's own behalf. However, you will not receive any further notice of the proceeding unless requested by you.
