

We understand that the Corporate Commission has been advised to approve telephone service to Silverbell Estates. That is great news for us, however, we have also been told that ONLY Silverbell Estates would be a local call. This makes absolutely no sense at all! There are no businesses, churches, or other public places out here. We would like to ask that you PLEASE make Arizona City and Casa Grande, at the least, to be within an extended area service. I make anywhere from 5-10 calls per day to Casa Grande, this includes calling my husband, my doctor, sometimes my vet, and other personal calls to friends. This is done with a cell phone at an expensive rate with unreliable service! We need local, regular phone service to Casa Grande! There is a great need out here for the internet (many could not afford both a long distance charge AND the ISP charge) and our many elderly and disabled residents need reliable, inexpensive phone coverage to contact medical help! We, again, urge you to allow the EAS to be put in place to at least Arizona City and Casa Grande! It would be beneficial also to include Toltec and Eloy but if this is not allowed, PLEASE put Casa Grande within our local calling area.
