Dear Commissioners:


I am an APS rate payer, and object to APS passing through the fabricated Palo Verde shutdowns, and costs, to retail customers (rate payers) through ACC adjustor mechanisms. My concerns are based, among others, on the following:

A small City utility in Everett, Washington, obtained documentation that Enron had orchestrated "maintenance" shut downs of various generating facilities to artificially increase power prices. This fabrication set the stage for the California power crisis of recent past, and that is now in litigation.

The Palo Verde shut downs, and alleged related costs, appear to fall within the parameters of the Enron blueprint. The shut downs and alleged costs are specious, and rate adjustments through ACC adjustor mechanisms, and otherwise, should not be approved.

Further, the Commission should refer the APS applications and Palo Verde shutdowns to the State Attorney Generals office for investigation viv-a-vis violations of the Sherman and Clayton Anti-trust Acts, and related FTC & SEC regulations.
