PROCEDURAL ORDER

**BY THE COMMISSION:**

In Decision No. 67409 (November 2, 2004) the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") approved a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity for Red Rock Utilities LLC ("RRU") to provide water and wastewater service in Pinal County. Among other things, Decision No. 67409 ordered RRU to file Approvals to Construct for the off-site water facilities within 365 days of the effective date of the Decision.

On October 12, 2005, RRU filed a request to extend that deadline to file copies of the Approvals to Construct until January 2, 2006. RRU states that it completed all the work necessary to obtain the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality ("ADEQ") Approvals to Construct, has received approval from Pinal County and submitted the application for such approvals to ADEQ. RRU reports that ADEQ has until mid-November 2005 in which to issue the Approvals to Construct. Accordingly, RRU requests this short extension.


On October 17, 2005, Commission Utilities Division Staff ("Staff") filed a Memorandum supporting the request for extension.

RRU has met all other requirements of Decision No. 67409. RRU has made significant progress towards constructing the water and wastewater facilities to serve the area, including drilling two wells; obtaining its AZPDES permit for storm water construction general permit; obtaining an AZPDES permit for discharge of treated effluent; completing design and contracting for construction of the wastewater treatment facility; initiating its application for an aquifer protection permit and

1 began negotiating its first line extension agreement. It filed its application for the Approvals to  
2 Construct with ADEQ on September 16, 2005. ADEQ may issue the Approvals prior to November 2,  
3 2005, but it may take the entire 60 allowed for its review under the rules. RRU's request is  
4 reasonable and should be granted.

5 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the deadline established in Decision No. 67409 for Red  
6 Rock Utilities LLC to file copies of its Approvals to Construct for its water and wastewater facilities,  
7 shall be extended until January 2, 2006.
