PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

In Decision No. 67823 (May 5, 2005), the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") modified the limit on new service connections for Pine Water Company ("Pine Water" or "Company") to allow two new residential connections per month until further Order of the Commission or April 30, 2006, whichever occurs first. Decision No. 67823 also directed Pine Water and the Commission's Utilities Division Staff ("Staff") to, among other things, "submit jointly or separately, by no later than October 31, 2005, a report with recommendations regarding specific long-term solutions to the Pine Water shortage issues."

On October 27, 2005, Pine Water filed a Request for Extension of Deadline to File Water Supply Alternatives Report. The Company requested an extension until November 7, 2005 to analyze information recently provided to the Arizona Department of Water Resources regarding the Strawberry Hollow development, which is located within Pine Water's CC&N area.

On October 31, 2005, counsel for Pine Water and Staff contacted the Administrative Law Judge regarding the pending extension request. During the teleconference, it was agreed that Pine Water would be granted an extension until November 10, 2005 for file its report; that Staff and intervenors would be given until December 12, 2005 to file a response; and that the Company would have until December 23, 2005 to file a reply to any such responses. Counsel for Pine Water was directed to contact intervenors John Breninger and Robert Cassaro regarding these filing dates.

1 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Pine Water Company's request for an extension of time
2 to file its long-term solutions report in compliance with Decision 67823 is granted, and accordingly
3 the Company shall file such report by no later than November 10, 2005; Staff and intervenors shall
4 file responses by December 12, 2005; and the Company shall file a reply by December 23, 2005.

5 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in all other respects Decision No. 67823 shall remain in full
6 forces and effect.


