
**VALENCIA WATER COMPANY, INC.'S
WAIVER OF RIGHT TO NOTICE AND
REQUEST FOR EXPEDITED
RECOMMENDED ORDER**

Valencia Water Company, Inc. ("Valencia"), by and through its attorneys undersigned, hereby provides notice that it waives its right to receive ten (10) day notice of any Recommended Order under A.A.C. 14-3-110(B) and respectfully requests that the Hearing Division expedite the preparation of a Recommended Order for this matter. This matter involves financing for arsenic treatment. The pending Application was filed August 24, 2005 and requested expedited processing. The Water Infrastructure Financing Authority (WIFA) has approved the requested financing, subject to the Commission authorizing Valencia to enter into loans with WIFA. Valencia has already engineered and obtained Maricopa County Department of Environmental Services approval to construct some of the facilities to be funded by this financing. Additionally, a 48 million dollar sewer bonding project backed by the Town of Buckeye cannot go forward until there is assurance that the WIFA funding is available to address the arsenic issue within Valencia's service area.

1 On November 7, 2005, Staff docketed its Staff Report supporting approval of
2 the pending application. Valencia is aware that only one additional regular Open Meeting is
3 scheduled for 2005 (December 5th and 6th) and that the first regular Open Meeting in 2006 is
4 scheduled to be held January 24th and 25th. Delaying consideration of this matter until
5 January 24th and 25th of 2006 will create hardship for Valencia, its customers and the Town of
6 Buckeye. Therefore, it is requested that the Commission take all steps possible to have this
7 matter considered at the December 5th and 6th Open Meeting (or at any Special Meeting of the
8 Commission held thereafter).
