PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On June 30, 2005, Arizona Water Company ("Arizona Water") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an Application for an extension of its existing Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") for its Casa Grande system.

On July 21, 2005, Staff filed an Insufficiency Letter.

On August 30, 2005, Arizona Water filed Additional Information in Response to Staff's Insufficiency Letter.

On September 7, 2005, Staff filed a Letter of Sufficiency.

On September 26, 2005, by Procedural Order, Staff was ordered to file their Staff Report by November 10, 2005.

On November 2, 2005, the City of Eloy applied for intervention into this matter. Objection to this intervention should be filed by November 15, 2005.

On November 9, 2005, Staff filed a Motion for Extension of Time to file their Staff Report until November 17, 2005.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Staff shall file a Staff Report by November 17, 2005.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Intervenor testimony, if any, shall be filed no later than November 17, 2005.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that responses by the Applicant, if any, to Staff's Report or Intervenor testimony shall be filed no later than December 1, 2005.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any objection to the City of Eloy's intervention shall be filed by November 15, 2005.


