



Volo Communications of Arizona, Inc. ("Volo-AZ") has filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application to cancel its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate") to provide competitive resold local exchange and facilities-base local and long distance telecommunications services in the State of Arizona. The Certificate was granted by the Commission to Volo-AZ on April 21, 2004 in Decision 66940 in Docket No. T-04220A-03-0829.  
The application, report of the Commission's Utilities Division Staff, and any written exceptions to the staff report prepared by the Volo-AZ is available for inspection during regular business hours at the offices of the Commission located at 1200 W. Washington St., Phoenix, Arizona 85007 and at Volo-AZ, 151 S. Wymore Rd., Suite 3000, Alt. Springs, AZ 85274.  
Under appropriate circumstances, interested persons shall have 30 days from the date of this publication of legal notice to file objections to the application, to request a hearing, and to submit a motion to intervene in the proceeding. Intervention shall be in accordance with A.A.C. R14-3-105. Persons desiring to intervene must file a written motion to intervene with the Commission and send such motion to Volo-AZ or its counsel and to all parties of the record, and which at the minimum, shall contain the following: 1. The name, address, and telephone number of the proposed intervenor and of any party upon whom service of documents is to be made different than the intervenor; 2. A short statement of the proposed intervenor's interest in the proceeding (e.g. a customer of the company, a shareholder of the company, a competitor, etc.); 3. A statement certifying that a copy of the motion to intervene has been mailed to the company or its counsel and all parties of record in the case.  
A.A.C. R14-3-105 shall govern the granting of motions to intervene. The granting of intervention among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at the hearing and to cross-examine other witnesses. However, failure to intervene will not preclude any interested person or entity from appearing at the hearing and making a statement on their own behalf.
