PROCEDURAL ORDER

**BY THE COMMISSION:**

On July 26, 2005, Willow Valley Water Company ("Willow Valley" or "Company") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an Application for an extension of its existing Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") in Mohave County, Arizona.

On August 23, 2005, Staff filed an Insufficiency Letter.

On October 12, 2005, Willow Valley filed Supplemental Information in response to Staff's Insufficiency Letter.

On November 10, 2005, Staff filed a Letter of Sufficiency.

Pursuant to A.A.C. R14-3-101, the Commission now issues this Procedural Order to govern the preparation and conduct of this proceeding.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the **hearing** in the above-captioned matter shall commence on **February 1, 2006 at 10:00 a.m.**, or as soon thereafter as is practical, at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that intervention shall be in accordance with A.A.C. R14-3-105, except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before January 6, 2006.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Willow Valley Water Company shall provide public notice of the hearing in this matter, in the following form and style, with the heading in no less than 12 point bold type and the body in no less than 10 point regular type:

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Willow Valley Water Company shall publish notice of the  
2 Application in a newspaper of general circulation in the proposed extension area and shall mail to  
3 each property owner in the requested extension area a copy of the above notice by December 2, 2005.

4 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Willow Valley Water Company shall file certification of  
5 mailing/publication as soon as practical after the mailing/publication has been completed but not later  
6 than December 9, 2005.

7 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that notice shall be deemed complete upon mailing/publication  
8 of same, notwithstanding the failure of an individual to read or receive the notice.


9 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any testimony by Intervenors and Staff's testimony/Staff  
10 Report shall be filed by January 10, 2006.

11 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that responses by the Applicant, if any, to Staff's Report or  
12 Intervenor testimony shall be filed no later than January 24, 2006.

13 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113-Unauthorized  
14 Communications) applies to this proceeding as the matter is now set for public hearing.

15 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend,  
16 or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at  
17 hearing.
