MAYES PROPOSED AMENDMENT #1

Page 20, line 19, INSERT New Finding of Fact No. 49:

“During the hearing, Verizon’s witness testified that the Company is the ILEC for portions of La Paz County, Parker, Arizona, and for the Colorado River Indian Tribe. As such, Verizon stated that it would consider making DSL available to the approximately 6,000 customers in its ILEC territory, although it expressed some concern that the distances between wire centers could pose obstacles to the implementation of DSL. However, the Verizon witness also stated that substitute technologies such as Wi-Fi or Wi-Max could potentially be made available to its ILEC customers on a going forward basis. In order to promote the deployment of DSL and other broadband services in these areas, the Commission believes that Verizon should make either DSL or a substitute technology such as Wi-Fi or Wi-Max available to its ILEC customers within 12 months of the effective date of this Order.”

Page 23, line 15, INSERT NEW ORDERING PARAGRAPH:

“IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT the surviving merged entity shall within 12 months of the effective date of this Order make either DSL or Wi-Fi or Wi-Max available to customers in its ILEC territory.”
