35 **PETITION FOR LEAVE TO INTERVENE OF THE**
36 **SOUTHWEST ENERGY EFFICIENCY PROJECT**

40 Pursuant to the Rules of Practice and Procedure of the Arizona Corporation Commission

41 ("Commission"), the Southwest Energy Efficiency Project ("SWEEP") hereby petitions for leave to
42 intervene in the above-captioned consolidated docket and, in support thereof, states as follows:

43 1. SWEEP is a public interest organization promoting greater energy efficiency in a
44 six-state region including Arizona, Colorado, New Mexico, Nevada, Utah, and Wyoming.

1 SWEEP works on state energy legislation, analysis of energy efficiency opportunities and
2 potential, expansion of state and utility energy efficiency programs as well as the design
3 of these programs, and voluntary partnerships with the private sector to advance energy
4 efficiency. SWEEP is collaborating with utilities, state agencies, environmental groups,
5 universities, and energy specialists in Arizona and the region. SWEEP plans to engage in both
6 analysis and advocacy, and is conducting a major study of electricity energy efficiency potential
7 in the region. SWEEP is a joint project of the American Council for an Energy-Efficient
8 Economy (ACEEE) and the Land and Water Fund of the Rockies. Initial funding for SWEEP is
9 being provided by the Energy Foundation, Hewlett Foundation, U.S. Department of Energy, and
10 U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.

11 2. SWEEP works with Arizona customers, residential consumers, businesses, and
12 organizations on energy efficiency and electric resource issues. SWEEP has an interest in this
13 proceeding because the Commission's review of crucial electric restructuring and retail electric
14 competition issues, and its actions regarding requested variances of existing electric competition
15 rules, may affect the timing, quantity, and diversity of resources constructed in Arizona and acquired
16 by Arizona utilities, which, in turn, may impact the level of energy efficiency implemented in
17 Arizona, and the economy and environment of Arizona and the region.

18 3. Intervention by SWEEP will not unduly broaden the issues or delay the proceeding.
19 To the extent that this docket is consolidated with any other Commission dockets, SWEEP requests
20 that it be granted intervention status in the consolidated dockets.


