The Arizona Corporation Commission will hold a hearing on the Generic Proceedings Concerning Electric Restructuring Issues beginning June 17, 2002, at 9:30 a.m. at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007. Public comments will be taken in Phoenix on the first day of hearing. This hearing will address the divestiture of Arizona Public Service Company ("APS") generating assets to an affiliated company and related issues. A second proceeding, will address the competitive procurement of electric power by APS for its customers once APS has divested its existing generation. The general public are put on notice that the Commission may initiate rulemaking(s), or, pursuant to A.R.S. § 40-252, after hearing, enter such orders as may be appropriate relating to electric restructuring, including variances from Commission rules and/or Decisions.

The law provides for an open public hearing at which, under appropriate circumstances, interested parties may intervene. Intervention shall be permitted to any person entitled by law to intervene and having a direct and substantial interest in the matter. Persons desiring to intervene must file a written motion to intervene with the Commission, which motion should be sent APS or its counsel and to all parties of record, and which, at the minimum, shall contain the following:

1. The name, address, and telephone number of the proposed intervenor and of any party upon whom service of documents is to be made if different than the intervenor.
2. A short statement of the proposed intervenor's interest in the proceeding (e.g., a customer of APS, a shareholder of APS, etc.)
3. A statement certifying that a copy of the motion to intervene has been mailed to APS' counsel and to all parties of record in the case.

All motions to intervene should be filed by June 12, 2002. The granting of motions to intervene shall be governed by A.A.C.R14-3-105. The granting of intervention, among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at hearing and to cross-examine other witnesses. However, failure to intervene will not preclude any person from appearing at the hearing and making a statement on such person's own behalf.

The Commission does not discriminate on the basis of disability in admission to its public meetings.
