PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On April 13, 2005, Verizon Communications, Inc. ("Verizon") and MCI, Inc. ("MCI") on behalf of their regulated subsidiaries, filed a Joint Notice of Intent with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") pursuant to A.A.C. R14-2-803 concerning Verizon's proposed acquisition of MCI.

On December 2, 2005, pursuant to Rule 33(c) and (d) of the Rules of the Supreme Court, Randal S. Milch filed a Motion and Consent of Local Counsel for *pro hac vice* admission in the above-captioned matter on behalf of Verizon, and requested expedited treatment of the Motion. The Consent listed Deborah R. Scott of the law firm Snell & Wilmer, as the designated member of the State Bar with whom communication can be made and upon whom papers shall be served.

In the discretion of the Commission, Randal S. Milch should be permitted to appear and participate in the above-captioned matter.

13 to appear at all hearings and procedural conferences, as well as all Open Meetings for which the
14 matter is scheduled for discussion, unless counsel has previously been granted permission to
15 withdraw by the Administrative Law Judge.


