



Talk.com d/b/a The Phone Company d/b/a Network Services of New Hope has filed with Arizona Corporation Commission an application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to provide resold intrastate toll-communications services in the State of Arizona. Applicant will be required by the Commission to provide this service under the rates and charges and terms and conditions established by the Commission. A.R.S. 40-222 provides that the Commission may act on an application for a Certificate to provide resold telecommunications services without a hearing, or with a hearing if one is requested by any party.
