PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On October 4, 2001, the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") issued Decision No. 64084 which granted Talk.Com Holding Corporation d/b/a The Phone Company and also d/b/a Network Services of New Hope ("Talk.com") a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") to provide intrastate telecommunications services as a reseller within the State of Arizona.

Pursuant to Decision No. 64084, Talk.com was ordered notify the Compliance Section of the Utilities Division of the date the Company will begin or has begun providing service in Arizona and file conforming tariffs within 30 days of the effective date of the Decision.

On November 6, 2001, Talk.com filed a request for an extension of time to comply with the timelines prescribed in the Decision.

On January 29, 2002, Staff filed a memorandum recommending that Talk.com be given a 45 day extension to comply with the Decision. Staff indicated it would recommend denial of any further extensions in this matter.

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1 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Talk.Com Holding Corporation d/b/a The Phone
2 Company and also d/b/a Network Services of New Hope shall notify the Compliance Section of the
3 Utilities Division of the date that the Company will begin providing service to Arizona customers and
4 file conforming tariffs no later that April 12, 2002 or 30 days prior to providing service in Arizona,
5 whichever occurs first. No additional extensions will be granted and failure to comply with the
6 above-stated conditions will result in voidance of Talk.Com Holding Corporation d/b/a The Phone
7 Company and also d/b/a Network Services of New Hope's Certificate of Convenience and Necessity
8 without further order of the Commission.

9 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in the event that Talk.Com Holding Corporation d/b/a The
10 Phone Company and also d/b/a Network Services of New Hope fails to comply with all conditions,
11 thereby resulting in voidance of its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity, a new application for a
12 Certificate of Convenience and Necessity must be filed by Talk.Com Holding Corporation d/b/a The
13 Phone Company and also d/b/a Network Services of New Hope's and approved by the Commission
14 prior to commencement of service.


