Dear Mr. Olea:

Tucson Electric Power Company ("TEP") and Navopache Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("Navopache") hereby submit for your review and Commission approval the "Electric Service Authorization Agreement between Tucson Electric Power Company and Navopache Electric Cooperative, Inc." ("TEP-Navopache ESA"); and the "Electric Service Agreement between Navopache Electric Cooperative, Inc. and Reliant Processing LTD ("Navopache-Reliant ESA")<sup>1</sup>. Because of the sensitive information contained in each of the Agreements, TEP and Navopache respectively request that the Agreements be treated as confidential. TEP and Navopache will forward copies of this cover letter, but not copies of the Agreements, to Docket Control.

TEP and Navopache have entered into the Agreements in order to economically provide electric service to Reliant, who will have facilities within TEP's Springerville Generating Station Site, which is actually located in the Navopache service territory.




