

EXTENSION OF TIME. (DOCKET NO. T-03318A-00-0832)

On October 22, 2001, 1-800-RECONEX, Inc. ("RECONEX") submitted correspondence requesting an extension of time to comply with conditions in the decision granting RECONEX authority to provider resold interexchange telecommunications services (Decision No. 64067). RECONEX's CC&N was conditioned on the Company notifying the Compliance Section of the Utilities Division, within 30 days of the Order, of the date that the Company will begin or has begun providing service to Arizona customers. RECONEX is requesting additional time to comply with the Decision. Staff recommends that RECONEX be granted an extension of 365 days from the date of the Decision to comply with the Order. Staff will not recommend that any further extensions of time will be granted.


Pursuant to the Compliance Notice sent by the Commission to 1-800-RECONEX, Inc. ("Reconex") in the above-referenced docket, please accept this correspondence as Reconex's compliance action to notify the Compliance Section of the Utilities Division of the date Reconex will begin providing service to Arizona customers.

Reconex does not intend on providing service to Arizona customers any time in the near future. However, Reconex would like to receive and maintain its authority to provide long distance services in the state of Arizona. Therefore, Reconex proposes that the dates of compliance of November 5, 2001 to file a 30-day notice of providing service and the January 2, 2002 date to file a bond with the Commission be extended simply to thirty or sixty days before Reconex begins providing service.

Reconex will notify the Commission within any time frame desired by the Commission of the date Reconex will begin providing service to Arizona customers.
