

I am in receipt of a letter dated October 19, 2001 from Reconex (attached). Please be advised that I find this illusory 'compliance action' completely unacceptable and in direct violation of Decision No. 64067. In essence, the company is seeking to comply with the notice requirements of Decision No. 64067 by stating that it, "does not intend on providing service to Arizona customers any time in the near future."

The company's counter-proposal to an established Order of this Commission is not warranted. I do not support using valuable Commission resources on applications and compliance monitoring just so a telecommunication company can advertise it has *authority* to provide long-distance service in Arizona without actually providing it.

If Reconex - or any other company - is truly interested in providing Arizona consumers with a choice in telecommunication services, it will comply with the Commission's orders on a timely basis. Please note my position on this matter should a similar one arise in the future.

Pursuant to the Compliance Notice sent by the Commission to 1-800-RECONEX, Inc. ("Reconex") in the above-referenced docket, please accept this correspondence as Reconex's compliance action to notify the Compliance Section of the Utilities Division of the date Reconex will begin providing service to Arizona customers.

Reconex does not intend on providing service to Arizona customers any time in the near future. However, Reconex would like to receive and maintain its authority to provide long distance services in the state of Arizona. Therefore, Reconex proposes that the dates of compliance of November 5, 2001 to file a 30-day notice of providing service and the January 2, 2002 date to file a bond with the Commission be extended simply to thirty or sixty days before Reconex begins providing service.

Reconex will notify the Commission within any time frame desired by the Commission of the date Reconex will begin providing service to Arizona customers.
