COMPLIANCE DUE DATE: 10/4/2002 **OR,**

COMPLIANCE ACTION: Certificate conditioned on Company procuring a performance bond equal to \$10,000. Proof of the performance bond should be filed in Docket Control within 90 days of the effective date of the Commission's Decision or 30 days prior to the provision of service, whichever comes first. The \$10,000 bond should be increased if at any time it would be insufficient to cover prepayments or deposits collected from its customers.

3-11-02 Procedural Order granted an extension of time to October 4, 2002 or 30 days prior to providing service in Arizona, whichever occurs first. No additional extensions of time will be granted and failure to comply will result in voidance of the Certificate of Convenience and Necessity without further Order of the Commission.
