
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- 4. Copy of the Notice published in the White Mountain Independent on April 20, 2001;


Please also be advised, NEC has discussed with ACC Staff the fact that the last mailing occurred April 26, 2001 (one day after the April 25, 2001 deadline set forth in the Rate Case Procedural Order). NEC performed the mailing as part of its April billings (the first month after the Rate Case Procedural Order was entered). NEC has nine separate billing cycles. The April billings commenced April 3, 2001, and were completed on April 26, 2001. Recognizing that the hearing on this matter is set for October 30, 2001 and that the intervention deadline extends until June 28, 2001, Staff indicated it had no objection to the one day of additional time needed to complete the mailing and publication.



PUBLIC NOTICE OF HEARING ON THE RATE APPLICATION OF NAVOPACHE ELECTRIC CO-OP

On February 20, 2001, Navopache Electric Cooperative ("Navopache") filed an application with the Arizona Corporation Commission for a 12.75 percent increase over adjusted test year revenues, and Navopache proposes to purchase power savings to reduce the net increase to customers to 0.43 percent. The actual percentage rate increase for individual customers will vary depending upon the type and quantity of service provided. Copies of the Navopache's application and proposed tariffs are available at its office and the Commission's offices for public inspection during regular business hours.

The Commission will hold a hearing on this matter beginning October 30, 2001 at 10:00 a.m. at the commission's offices, 1200 West Washington, Phoenix, Arizona. Public comments will be taken on the first day of the hearing.

The law provides for an open public hearing at which, under appropriate circumstances, interested parties may intervene. Intervention shall be permitted to any person entitled by law to intervene and having a direct and substantial interest in the matter. Persons desiring to intervene must file a written motion to intervene with the Commission, which motion should be sent to Navopache or its counsel and to all parties of record, and which, at the minimum, shall contain the following:

1. The name, address, and telephone number of the proposed intervenor and of any party upon whom service of documents is to be made if different than the intervenor.
2. A short statement of the proposed intervenor's interest in the proceeding (e.g., a customer of Navopache, a stockholder of Navopache, etc.).
3. A statement certifying that a copy of the motion to intervene has been mailed to Navopache or its counsel and to all parties of record in the case.

The granting of motions to intervene shall be governed by A.A.C., R14-3-105, except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before June 28, 2001. The granting of intervention, among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at hearing and to cross-examine other witnesses. However, failure to intervene will not preclude any customer from appearing at the hearing and making a statement on such customer's own behalf.

The Commission does not discriminate on the basis of disability in admission to its public meetings. Persons with a disability may request a reasonable accommodation such as a sign language interpreter, as well as request this document in an alternative format, by contacting Shelly Hood, AD/Coordinator, voice phone number 602-542-3931. 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
