Dear Messrs. Cheney and Petrillo:

On July 22, 1998, All Com USA d/b/a AllCom, AllCom International filed an application for a CC&N to provide resold intrastate toll telecommunications in the State of Arizona. We only have an application for resold long distance service. Pursuant to A.A.C. R14-2-1104(E), the Applicant is required to publish legal notice of the application in all counties where services will be provided no later than 20 days after the application is filed. The Applicant must file with the Commission copies of the affidavits of publication for each newspaper in which public notice in this matter was published.

We did receive publication for Pima county. If AllCom desires to do service statewide, then further publishing must be completed. We also received publication for Maricopa county. However, the newspaper in which it was published, does not have circulation in all of Maricopa county (just in a very small town). Therefore, we ask that publishing for Maricopa county be completed again.

Publication in The Arizona Republic is one method of publishing legal notice statewide. Publication in the Arizona Business Gazette is one method of publishing legal notice in Maricopa county. You can contact John Fearing, Executive Director of the Arizona Newspapers Association, at (602) 261-7655 for information on these and other newspapers, which publish in each county, and for rate quotes. Enclosed is a sample of public notice and sample proof of publication.

Additionally, in order for Staff to continue with its review of this application, the following information must be submitted:

- A. Include a copy of your Company's most recent balance sheet, income statement, audit report (if audited), and all related notes to these financial statements.

B. If the balance sheets you submit do not have retained earnings accounts, please provide this account information on a separate sheet.


This information must be received by Docket Control within 30 days of the date of this letter. Please mail an original plus 10 copies to: Docket Control, Arizona Corporation Commission, 1200 W Washington Street, Phoenix, AZ 850070-2927. If no response is received within 30 days, Staff will recommend that the application be terminated. If the application is terminated, the Applicant cannot provide resold intrastate toll telecommunications in Arizona, until such time as a new application is filed with and approved by the Commission.

A data request was sent to Mike Petrillo on May 8, 2000, listing these same requests. It was not answered in the 30 days requested. Once 60 days have passed (since the initial data request), without response to this letter, then recommendation for termination of the application will be made. I am emailing this data request as well as mailing you a copy. This copy will be docketed with Docket Control so that it can be determined if AllCom is in violation of promptly responding to this data request.

Your response to each of these data requests must be received by July 8, 2000.

Remember that information submitted for a CC&N should be made public record (including financial statements). If you have any questions, please contact me at (602) 542-0742. Thank you for your prompt response to this request.
