PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On October 30, 2001, the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") issued Decision No. 64178 which granted LightSource Telecom I, LLC ("LightSource") a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") to provide competitive facilities-based and resold local exchange, interexchange and exchange access telecommunications services in the State of the Arizona.

Pursuant to Decision No. 64178, LightSource was ordered to: 1) file conforming tariffs within 30 days of the date of the Decision; 2) file a performance bond for a minimum of \$100,000 within 90 days of the date of the Decision; 3) file certification that all issues associated with the provisions of 911 service have been resolved within 30 days of the Decision; and 4) its plan to have its customers' telephone numbers included in the incumbent's Directories and Directory Assistance databases within 30 days of the date of the Decision.

On November 13, 2001, LightSource filed a request for an extension to file the above-named provisions.

On November 20, 2001, Staff filed a memorandum recommending that LightSource be given a one-time extension until October 30, 2002 or until 30 days prior to providing service, whichever is sooner, to submit the compliance filings. Staff indicated it would recommend denial of any further extensions in this matter.

1 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that LightSource Telecom I, LLC shall file its conforming
2 tariffs, performance bond, certification of 911 service and plan to have its customers phone numbers
3 included in the incumbent's Directories and Directory Assistance no later that October 30, 2002 or 30
4 days prior to providing service in Arizona, whichever occurs first.
