NOTICE OF COMPLIANCE WITH
COMMISSION'S DECISION NO. 64249

On June 4, 2001, Qwest Communications Corporation ("QCC") and certain of its subsidiaries and affiliates¹ made a joint application for approval by the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") to transfer Certificates of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&Ns") in connection with internal transactions to effectuate a corporate restructuring. Commission Staff and QCC entered into a stipulation regarding the Proposed Order Granting Transfer of Certificates of Convenience and Necessity on November 16, 2001. As a result, on December 7, 2002, the Commission issued Decision No. 64249 approving the requested transfer and requiring, among other things, that QCC file a new tariff in conjunction with its application to provide competitive facilities-based inter-LATA services in the Docket No. T-02811B-01-0895 by May 7, 2002 (90 days from the issuance of the Decision.)

On March 1, 2002, QCC filed a Motion to Extend Time for Filing Proposed Tariff in Docket No. T-02811B-01-0895 ("Motion") by an additional 90 days, until June 5, 2002, because QCC needed the additional time to prepare its product offerings, associated tariffs, and

1 the documentation to support its proposed tariffs. On March 14, 2002 the Commission granted
2 QCC's Motion.

3 On May 24, 2002, QCC submitted the tariff for facilities-based inter-LATA
4 services in Docket No. T-02811B-01-0895. QCC, by and through its undersigned counsel,
5 hereby confirms its compliance with certain terms of the Commission's Decision No. 64249 by
6 the filing of the tariff for facilities-based inter inter-LATA services in Docket No. T-02811B-01-
7 0895.
