
Dear Mr. Lovell:

On January 25, 2002, you filed with Docket Control of the Arizona Corporation Commission another letter that asked certain questions concerning Decision No. 64286. Specifically, you asked if the Decision is still in effect and whether Bradshaw can appeal the Decision.

Regarding your first question, the Commission treated your letter docketed on January 7, 2002 as an application for rehearing pursuant to A.R.S § 40-253. A.R.S § 40-253(D) states that "[a]n application for rehearing shall not excuse any person from complying with and obeying any order or decision, or any requirements of any order or decision of the commission ...." Therefore, the Decision and the requirements contained therein are still in effect.

Concerning your rights to appeal the Decision in this case, I would reiterate what I stated in my letter to you dated January 10, 2002. In that letter, I included some statutes for your review and I suggested that you consult an attorney who is familiar with that area of law and seek his or her advice on how to appeal a Decision from the Arizona Corporation Commission. I would also suggest you contact such attorney immediately to ensure Bradshaw's ability to commence any action within the timelines prescribed by law.
