

CenturyTel Long Distance, L.L.C. ("Applicant") has filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") its Application to Discontinue and/or Abandon Competitive Resold Intrastate Toll Communication Services (the "Application"). If the Commission approves the Application, the Applicant will no longer offer long distance services in Arizona.

The Commission may act on the Application with or without a hearing. The Application is available for inspection during regular business hours at the Commission's office at 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007, or at the offices of the Applicant, 100 CenturyTel Drive, Monroe, LA 71203-2041.

Intervention in the Commission's proceedings on the Applications shall be permitted to any person entitled by law to intervene and having a direct and substantial interest in this matter in accordance with A.A.C. R14-3-105. Persons desiring to intervene must file a motion to intervene with the Commission which must be served upon the applicants and which, at a minimum, must contain the following information:

1. The name, address, and telephone number of the proposed intervenor and any person upon whom service of documents is to be made if different from the intervenor.

2. A short statement of the proposed intervenor's interest in the proceeding (e.g., a customer or potential customer of Applicants, a shareholder of Applicants, etc.).

3. Whether the proposed intervenor desires a formal evidentiary hearing on the application and the reasons for such a hearing.

4. A statement certifying that a copy of the motion to intervene has been mailed to Applicants or their counsel ad to all parties of record in the case.

The granting of intervention, among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at the hearing and to cross-examine other witnesses. However, failure to intervene will not preclude any interested person or entity from appearing at the hearing and providing public comment on the Application. You will not receive any further notice of this proceeding unless you request it.
