PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

14 On September 30, 2005, the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") issued
15 Decision No. 68190 which approved the applications of Cave Creek Water Company ("Company" or
16 "Applicant") for extensions of its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate") to provide
17 public water utility service to Parcel Nos. 216-29-0024 (Parcel 216) and 211-99-006 ("Parcel 211")
18 in Maricopa County, Arizona. As a condition of the Commission's approval, the Company was to
19 file a copy of the Certificate of Approval to Construct ("CAC") which was to be issued by the
20 Maricopa County Department of Environmental Services ("MCDES") for the Company's final
21 arsenic treatment plan by December 31, 2005.

22 On December 29, 2005, the Company filed a Motion to Extend Time to File Approval to
23 Construct ("Motion") stating that it needs an additional six months, until June 30, 2006, to file a copy
24 of its CAC.

25 On January 4, 2006, by Procedural Order, the Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") was
26 ordered to file a response to the Applicant's Motion.

27 On January 13, 2006, Staff filed a memorandum which states that Staff does not oppose the
28 Company's Motion for a six month extension to file the required documentation by June 30, 2006.


Accordingly, the Company's Motion should be granted and a six month extension approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Motion of Cave Creek Water Company is hereby

1 granted and a six month extension until June 30, 2006, is hereby approved for the filing of the
2 Certificate of Approval to Construct.

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the presiding Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter,
4 amend, or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by
5 ruling at hearing.


