

AN ORDER
TO TEMPORARILY EXCEED THE 7%
SHORT-TERM DEBT LIMITATION
BY THE ARIZONA ELECTRIC POW-
ER COOPERATIVE, INC.**

The Arizona Electric Power Cooperative, Inc. has filed an Emergency Application with the Arizona Corporation Commission for an order authorizing it to temporarily exceed the seven percent short-term debt limitation of A.R.S. § 40-302.D. The application is available for inspection during regular business hours at the office of the Commission in Phoenix, Arizona, and the Company's offices at 1000 South Highway 80, Benson, Arizona 85602. Intervention in the Commission's proceedings on the application shall be permitted to any person entitled by law to intervene and having a direct substantial interest in this matter. Persons desiring to intervene must file a Motion to Intervene with the Commission which must be served upon applicant and which, at a minimum, shall contain the following information:

1. The name, address and telephone number of the proposed intervenor and of any person upon whom service of documents is to be made if different than the intervenor.
2. A short statement of the proposed intervenor's interest in the proceeding.
3. Whether the proposed intervenor desires a formal evidentiary hearing on the application and the reasons for such a hearing.
4. A statement certifying that a copy of the Motion to Intervene has been mailed to Applicant.

The granting of Motions to Intervene shall be governed by A.A.C. R14-3-105.
