BY THE COMMISSION:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Sulphur Springs Valley Electric Cooperative ("SSVEC") is certificated to provide electric service as a public service corporation in the State of Arizona.
2. On January 16, 2002, SSVEC filed an application for approval of revisions to its tariffs, Schedules GT, PT, and RT. Schedule GT (General Service & Small Power Time of Use), Schedule PT (General Power Service Time of Use), and Schedule RT (Residential Time of Use) are currently experimental time-of-use tariffs.
3. Staff has recommended that the application be suspended for 120 days so that Staff can have sufficient time to evaluate the application.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. SSVEC is an Arizona public service corporation within the meaning of Article XV, Section 2, of the Arizona Constitution.
2. The Commission has jurisdiction over SSVEC and over the subject matter of the application.
3. The Commission, having reviewed the application and Staff's Memorandum dated January 18, 2002, concludes that it is in the public interest to suspend the filing for a period of one hundred twenty (120) days.
