**MOTION FOR EXPEDITED
PROCEDURAL CONFERENCE**

Perkins Mountain Water Company (the "Water Company") and Perkins Mountain Utility Company (the "Sewer Company") (collectively, the "Companies") through undersigned counsel hereby request an expedited procedural conference in the above-captioned matter. On March 6, 2006, the Companies docketed a Response to a letter issued by Commissioner Kristin Mayes, dated February 17, 2006. In its Response, the Water Company responded to Commissioner Mayes' concerns regarding water adequacy for the proposed master planned communities in this docket.

As set forth in its Response to Commissioner Mayes, although the Water Company has followed state water statutes and Commission rules, policies and practices in pursuit of its CC&N, the Water Company is mindful of the concerns raised regarding water adequacy. To alleviate the Commission's concerns, the Companies would like to supplement the record setting forth the steps taken by the developer to secure an adequate water supply through the Arizona Department of Water Resources ("ADWR"). The Water Company is further seeking to modify its CC&N application, limiting the

1 conditional CC&N to that portion of the Golden Valley development that can be served
2 with the existing 9,000 acre-feet of water that ADWR has determined to be physically
3 available. In addition, the Water Company would not oppose the issuance of an Order
4 Preliminary for the remainder of the Golden Valley development, as well as for the
5 White Hills development, until such time as the developer obtains a determination from
6 ADWR that adequate water is available for those areas.

7 The Companies seek this procedural conference on an expedited basis, as this
8 case is scheduled for open meeting the week of March 15, 2006. The purpose of the
9 conference is to seek direction from the Administrative Law Judge how best to
10 supplement the record and revise the Application.

11 To support the Water Company's revised Application, it seeks to supplement the
12 record to include revised maps and legal descriptions to identify that portion of the
13 request that would adequately be served by the existing 9,000 acre-feet. In addition, the
14 Water Company seeks permission to submit into the record the Mohave County Board of
15 Supervisors Board Resolutions as approved on December 29, 2005, which require the
16 developer to demonstrate that an adequate water supply exists for both the Golden
17 Valley and White Hills projects prior to constructing those developments.

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
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
