PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 17, 2006, Qwest Corporation ("Qwest") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application and approval of interconnection agreement with AzCom Paging, Inc., Smith Bagley Inc., Handy Page, AnswerPhone Inc., Star Page Inc., Glen Canyon Communications Inc., Nextel West Corp., Western Wireless Corporation, Tele-Page, Inc., Westsky Wireless, L.L.C. and Pac West Telecomm Inc. (collectively "Carriers").

Pursuant to the Act, the Commission must act on the request within 120 days, in this case, by July 11, 2006.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that a **Procedural Conference** to discuss the appropriate way to proceed with this application, including potential hearing dates, shall be scheduled for **March 29, 2006, at 10:00 a.m.**, at the offices of the Commission, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the costs to transcribe the proceedings shall be borne equally by Qwest and the Carriers.

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Rule 33(c) and (d) of the
2 Rules of the Arizona Supreme Court with respect to practice of law and admission *pro hac vice*.

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that withdrawal of representation must be made in compliance
4 with A.A.C. R14-3-104(E) and Rule 1.16 of the Rules of Professional Conduct (under Rule 42 of the
5 Rules of Arizona Supreme Court). Representation before the Commission includes the obligation to
6 appear at all hearings and procedural conferences, as well as all Open Meetings for which the matter
7 is scheduled for discussion, unless counsel has previously been granted permission to withdraw by
8 the Administrative Law Judge or the Commission.

9 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Arbitrator may rescind, alter, amend, or waive any
10 portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.


