RE: IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF ICR WATER USERS ASSOCIATION, INC. FOR AN EXTENSION OF ITS CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY TO PROVIDE WATER SERVICE TO PORTIONS OF YAVAPAI COUNTY, DOCKET NO. W-02824A-01-0450, DECISION NO. ~~64360~~ REQUEST FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO COMPLY

On January 14, 2003, ICR Water Users Association, Inc. ("ICR") filed a Notice of Compliance and request for a 60 day extension of time to provide a revised main extension agreement between ICR and the developer which provides for the ownership of the water production wells to being conveyed to ICR.

In Decision No. 64360, (January 15, 2002) the Commission conditioned its approval of the extension of ICR's Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (Certificate) on the Company filing the following items within 365 days from the effective date of the Commission's Decision:

- 1.) A copy of the developer's water adequacy report for Phase I, issued by the Arizona Department of Water Resources ("ADWR").
- 2.) A copy of the developer's Certificate of Approval to Construct, issued by the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality ("ADEQ") with the appropriate main extension agreement.
- 3.) A copy of ICR's Yavapai County Franchise for the extension area.
- 4.) An amended agreement between ICR and the developer which provides for the ownership of the water production wells to be transferred to ICR.

On June 14, 2002, the developer filed in this docket a copy of the ADWR water adequacy report for Phase of Talking Rock Ranch. On January 13, 2003, ICR filed in this docket a copy of the developer's Certificate of Approval to Construct water facilities for Talking Rock Ranch. ICR also timely filed its franchise agreement with Yavapai County which includes the extension area.

ICR's has requested a 60 day extension of time in which to file its one outstanding compliance item, an amended main extension agreement evidencing the developer's water production well is transferred to ICR. ICR has timely filed all of the other required documentation. Providing ICR with an additional 60 in which to file the agreement is reasonable. Staff has no objections to ICR's request and recommends approval of an extension of time to March 12, 2003, to comply with Decision No. 64360.
