11 On September 19, 2001, Voyager Water company ("VWC" or "Applicant") filed with the
12 Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for an extension of its Certificate
13 of Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate") to provide water service in Pima County, Arizona.

14 On October 3, 2001, VWC filed an Amendment to the application.

15 On October 3, 2001, VWC filed an Affidavit of Publication.

16 Pursuant to A.R.S. §41-1074.C, this Application is deemed administratively complete.

17 Pursuant to A.A.C. R14-3-101, the Commission now issues this Procedural Order to govern
18 the preparation and conduct of this proceeding.

19 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the hearing in the above-captioned matter shall
20 commence on December 10, 2001, at 2:30 p.m., or as soon thereafter as is practical, at the
21 Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007.

22 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that intervention shall be in accordance with A.A.C. R14-3-105,
23 except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before November 27, 2001.

24 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that objections to any motions to intervene must be filed on or
25 before December 4, 2001.

26 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Applicant shall provide public notice of the hearing in
27 this matter, in the following form and style:

1 practicable after the mailing has been completed but not later than December 4, 2001.

2 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that notice shall be deemed complete upon mailing of same,
3 notwithstanding the failure of an individual to read or receive the notice.

4 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Staff shall file a Staff Report by November 27, 2001.

5 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Applicant shall file any objections to the Staff Report
6 by December 4, 2001.

7 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113-Unauthorized
8 Communications) applies to this proceeding as the matter is now set for public hearing.

9 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the time periods specified herein shall not be extended
10 pursuant to Rule 6(a) or (e) of the Rules of Civil Procedure.

11 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend, or waive
12 any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.
