**BY NAVOPACHE ELECTRIC**  
**COOPERATIVE, INC.**  
Navopache Electric Cooperative, Inc. (Applicant) has filed an Application with the Arizona Corporation Commission (Commission) for an order authorizing Applicant to issue \$33,231,000.00 in debt to finance the construction and operation of electric facilities (Docket No. E-01787A-05-0719). The application is available for inspection during regular business hours at the office of the Commission in Phoenix, Arizona, and the Applicant's office in Lakeside, Arizona.  
Intervention in the Commission's proceedings on the application shall be permitted to any person entitled by law to intervene and having a direct substantial interest in this matter. Persons desiring to intervene must file a motion to intervene and thirteen copies with the Commission's Docket Control at 1200 West Washington, Phoenix, Arizona, and serve a copy upon the Applicant c/o Michael A. Curtis, Curt, Goodwin, Sullivan, Udall & Schwab, P.L.C., 2712 North 7th Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85006. At a minimum, a motion to intervene shall contain the following information:  
1. The name, address and telephone number of the proposed intervenor and of any person upon whom service of documents is to be made if different than the intervenor.  
2. A short statement of the proposed intervenor's interest in the proceeding.  
3. Whether the proposed intervenor desires a formal evidentiary hearing on the application and the reasons for such a hearing.  
4. A statement certifying that a copy of the motion to intervene has been mailed to Applicant.  
The granting of motions to intervene shall be governed by A.A.C. R14-3-105, except that all motions to intervene must be filed on, or before, the 15th day after the date this notice is published.
