PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On November 23, 1999, the Securities Division ("Division") of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") filed a Temporary Order to Cease and Desist ("Temporary Order") and Notice of Opportunity for Hearing ("Notice") against the above-captioned Respondents in which the Division alleged multiple violations of the Securities Act of Arizona.

On December 14, 1999, counsel for the above-captioned Respondents filed a Request for Hearing in response to the Temporary Order and Notice. Therein, Respondents indicated that they agreed to cease and desist from the conduct complained of in the Temporary Order and Notice and waived their rights under A.A.C. R14-4-307 effectively tolling the termination of the Temporary Order until further order of the Commission. Respondents requested that a hearing be set in February, 2000 and indicated that they were attempting to reach a settlement of this matter.

Counsel for the Division indicated that it did not oppose the Respondents' request.



According to the Division, the Division and the Respondents have entered settlement negotiations and have requested that the pre-hearing conference be continued and that they will
