**DESERT ENERGY L.L.C.
TEN YEAR PLAN
Filed Pursuant to A.R.S. §40-360.02**

1. Size and Proposed Route:

The transmission line will be located in Pinal County, Arizona and be constructed for 500 kV operation. The line is projected to be approximately one half to one mile in length and will terminate on one end at the proposed Desert Energy power plant site. The legal description for the plant site including the land for the plant switchyard is as follows:

That part of the West One-Half (W1/2) of the Southwest One-Quarter (SW 1/4) of Section 10 lying Northeasterly of the right-of-way line of the Southern Pacific Railroad in Township 10 South, Range 10 East, Gila and Salt River Meridian, Pinal County, Arizona.

The line will connect at the plant switchyard and proceed east to APS's Saguaro Substation. The proposed plant site and transmission line route is shown on the following figure.

4. Average and Maximum Power Output:

5. Expected Capacity Factor:

6. Type of Fuel:

7. Power Flow and Stability Analysis Report.

The contemplated transmission line, a radial connection to the Saguaro Substation, will as a stand alone facility result in negligible impacts to power flow and stability of the integrated Arizona transmission system. However, in conjunction with the purpose of the line, to deliver power from the proposed Desert Energy power plant to the Arizona wholesale market, the system impacts of the combined plant and line facilities are presented in a separate document titled "Ten Year Plan Power Flow and Stability," filed on January 15, 2002 as part of the Desert Energy power plant Ten Year Plan.
