PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On January 13, 2006, Gold Canyon Sewer Company ("Gold Canyon" or "Company") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for a determination of the current fair value of its utility plant and property and for increases in its rates and charges for wastewater utility service provided to customers in the Company's certificated service area in Pinal County, Arizona.

By Procedural Order issued February 27, 2006, a hearing in this matter was scheduled to commence on September 25, 2006, publication of the application and hearing date was ordered, and other procedural deadlines were established.

On March 3, 2006, Gold Canyon filed a Request for Change of Hearing Date. The Company indicated that its lead counsel has a scheduling conflict on the established hearing date and therefore requested that the hearing be rescheduled for the following week. The Motion states that Staff counsel does not oppose the requested change.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the **hearing in this matter shall be rescheduled to commence on October 3, 2006, at 10:00 a.m.**, or as soon thereafter as is practical, at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington, Phoenix, Arizona 85007.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Gold Canyon shall substitute the revised hearing date in the public notice set forth in the February 27, 2006 Procedural Order.

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED in all other respects the February 27, 2006 Procedural Order
2 shall remain in full force and effect.

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113-Unauthorized
4 Communications) continues to apply to this proceeding as the matter is now set for public hearing.

5 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend,
6 or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at
7 hearing.


