

### PUBLIC NOTICE OF HEARING ON THE APPLICATION OF ARIZONA WATER CO. FOR AN EXTENSION OF ITS CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY

Docket No. W-01445A-05-0701

On October 4, 2005, Arizona Water Company ("AWC" or "Applicant") filed an application with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") for an extension of its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") to provide water utility service in Pinal County, Arizona. If the application is granted, the Applicant would be the exclusive provider of water to the proposed area, and would be required by the Commission to provide service under rates and charges and terms and conditions established by the Commission. The application is available for inspection during regular business hours at the offices of the Commission in Phoenix, at 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona, and at the offices of the Company, 2380 W. Southern Avenue, Apache Junction, Arizona 85220 and on the internet via the Commission website ([www.azcc.gov](http://www.azcc.gov)) using the e-docket function.

The Commission will hold a hearing on this matter beginning April 6, 2006 at 10:00 a.m., at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona. Public comment will be taken on the first day of the hearing.

The law provides for an open public hearing at which, under appropriate circumstances, interested parties may intervene. Intervention shall be permitted to any person entitled by law to intervene and having a direct and substantial interest in the matter. Persons desiring to intervene must file a written motion to intervene with the Commission, which motion should be sent to the Applicants or its counsel and to all parties of record, and which, at the minimum, shall contain the following:

1. The name, address, and telephone number of the proposed intervenor and of any party upon whom service of documents is to be made if different than the intervenor.
2. A short statement of the proposed intervenor's interest in the proceeding (e.g., a customer of the Applicant, a shareholder of the Applicant, a competitor, etc.).
3. A statement certifying that a copy of the motion to intervene has been mailed to the Applicant or its counsel and to all parties of record in the case.

The granting of motions to intervene shall be governed by A.A.C. R14-3-105, except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before March 23, 2006. The granting of intervention, among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at hearing and to cross-examine other witnesses. Failure to intervene will not preclude any person or entity customer appearing at the hearing and making a statement on their own behalf. You will not, however, receive any further notice of the proceeding unless requested by you. Please check with the Commission for any changes to the scheduled hearing date.
