

early January 2000, regarding *Infospace v. Internet Yellow Pages, Inc.*, NO. C98-1835Z, United States District Court, For The Western District Of Washington At Seattle. Mr. Bentley is further required to try an AAA Arbitration case on January 24, 2000, that will go approximately four days (*Murray I. Malin and Roberta L. Malin v. Insurance Claims Yellow Pages International, Inc.*, American Arbitration Association Number 76 114 00064 99). Preparation time and depositions scheduled for the 4th, 5th, and 7th of January in the *Malin* case make it impossible to further schedule in the matter before the Arizona Corporation Commission prior to February 2000.

Based upon the foregoing, it is respectfully requested that the matter be continued and Respondents stipulate that the Cease and Desist Order may remain in full force and effect pending the hearing.
